Live Oak Street, Red Oak, Texas, and by videoconference as authorized by Section 551.127 of the Texas Government Code, at which time the following will be discussed and considered:

As authorized by Section 551.071 of the Texas Government Code, this meeting may be convened into closed Executive Session for the purpose of seeking confidential legal advice from the City Attorney on any agenda item listed herein.

CALL TO ORDER: The Mayor will call the meeting to order, declare a quorum, if present, and declare notices legally posted pursuant to the Open Meetings Act.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: The public may address City Council on any topic. Speakers should complete a Public Comments form and submit it to the City Secretary by 6:30 p.m. To submit written comments via email, see the instructions at the bottom of the agenda. The Texas Open Meetings Act prohibits City Council from discussing or taking action on issues not posted on the agenda; however, the Mayor, City Manager, or designee may provide specific factual information, recite an existing policy, or schedule a discussion of the issue. Speakers are limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes.

TAXPAYER IMPACT STATEMENT

House Bill 1522, passed by the Texas Legislature in 2025, amends Section 551.043 of the Texas Government Code to require that the notice of a meeting required to be posted under Section 551.043(a) of the Texas Open Meetings Act, at which a governmental body will discuss or adopt a budget for the governmental body, must include a taxpayer impact statement showing, for the median-valued homestead property, a comparison of the property tax bill in dollars for the same property for the upcoming fiscal year.

NOTE: The estimates in this impact statement are valid only for the preliminary proposed budget. The preliminary proposed budget and the preliminary tax rate may each be adjusted by City Council at any time before their final adoption.
