



**MEETING MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Stanfill called the special meeting of the Red Oak City Council to order at 6:31 p.m., on Monday, June 15, 2026, declared a quorum present, and declared that notices were legally posted pursuant to the Open Meetings Act.

The Texas Open Meetings Act prohibits City Council from discussing or taking action on issues not posted on the agenda; however, the Mayor, City Manager or designee may provide specific factual information, recite an existing policy, or schedule a discussion of the issue for possible placement on a future agenda. Speakers are limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes.

Kathryn Hitz, 1105 Goodloe Lane, Red Oak, Texas, spoke about the noise ordinance and her concerns about the wording on Ordinance No. 26-014, PD 491. Kathryn stated she wanted clarification.

Sharon Cotton, 502 Bluebonnet Lane, Red Oak, Texas, spoke regarding code compliance for signs regarding the Data Center.

Chris Moses, 120 Stainback Court, Red Oak, Texas, spoke about the placement of Data Center signs in the rights of way. He also stated that Data Bank has been working on the Stainback property on Sunday which is not allowed. He also asked if Batchler Road would become four lanes or two lanes with a turn lane.
