Pursuant to Section 551 of the Texas Government Code, notice is hereby given of a Special Called Meeting of the Red Oak City Council to be held on Monday, August 17, 2026, at 6:30 p.m., in the Red Oak Government Center, Council Chamber, 101 S. Live Oak Street, Red Oak, Texas, and by videoconference as authorized by Section 551.127 of the Texas Government Code, at which time the following will be discussed and considered:

As authorized by Section 551.071 of the Texas Government Code, this meeting may be convened into closed Executive Session for the purpose of seeking confidential legal advice from the City Attorney on any agenda item listed herein.

CALL TO ORDER: The Mayor will call the meeting to order, declare a quorum, if present, and declare notices legally posted pursuant to the Open Meetings Act.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: The public may address City Council on any topic. Speakers should complete a Public Comments form and submit it to the City Secretary. See instructions and deadlines for submitting a Public Comments form at the bottom of this agenda. The Texas Open Meetings Act prohibits City Council from discussing or taking action on issues not posted on the agenda; however, the Mayor, City Manager, or designee may provide specific factual information, recite an existing policy, or schedule a discussion of the issue. Speakers are limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes.

COUNCIL BUSINESS – REGULAR AGENDA:

1. Consider approval of Ordinance No. 26-025 of the City of Red Oak, Texas, adopting the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Annual Operating Budget in accordance with state law; approving and adopting a budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027; providing that expenditures for said fiscal year shall be made in accordance with said budget; appropriating and setting aside the necessary funds out of the general and other revenues for said fiscal year for the maintenance and operation of the various departments and for various activities and improvements of the City; providing for the repeal of all ordinances in conflict; providing a severability clause; and, providing an effective date. 2. Conduct a Public Hearing and consider approval of Ordinance No. 26-026 of the city of Red

Oak, Texas, levying Ad Valorem Taxes for the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 (Tax Year 2026) at a rate of \$0.497651 for Maintenance and Operations and a rate of \$0.197349 for Debt Service for a total rate of \$0.695000 per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation on all taxable property within the corporate city limits of the City of Red Oak as of January 1, 2026, to provide revenues for current expenses and debt service requirements; providing for due and delinquent dates together with penalties and interest; providing a severability clause; and, declaring an effective date. 3. Consider approval of Ordinance No. 26-027 of the City of Red Oak, Texas, to ratify the property tax increase reflected in the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 adopted Budget which raises more revenue from property taxes than the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 adopted Budget. (Tim McRoberts)

TAXPAYER IMPACT STATEMENT

House Bill 1522, passed by the Texas Legislature in 2025, amends Section 551.043 of the Texas Government Code to require that the notice of a meeting required to be posted under Section 551.043(a) of the Texas Open Meetings Act, at which a governmental body will discuss or adopt a budget for the governmental body, must include a taxpayer impact statement showing, for the median-valued homestead property, a comparison of the property tax bill in dollars for the same property for the upcoming fiscal year.

NOTE: The estimates in this impact statement are valid only for the preliminary proposed budget. The preliminary proposed budget and the preliminary tax rate may each be adjusted by City Council at any time before their final adoption.
