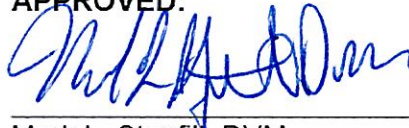

The motion passed unanimously.

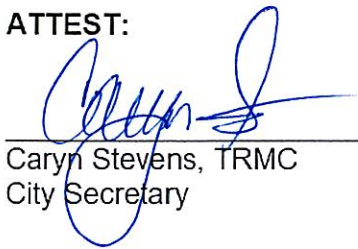
